The fee will cover the cost of one participant to attend this training and to help subsidize the cost of the equipment you will receive (valued at over \$1200), as well as curriculum and program support. All other participants from new or existing groups are expected to pay for each individual's training cost of \$90 per person. Meals and lodging are included in the \$90. The deadline to register for this event is October 6th. Registration after this date will be \$110 per person.
