SUBJECT: 2018 Water Quality Control Commission Appointments

The Colorado Water Quality Control Commission consists of nine members with staggered 3-year terms. Commission members are appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Colorado Senate. The following members' terms expire February 15, 2018: Mary Fabisiak (finishing her second term), Jon Slutsky (finishing his second term) and Rick Hum (finishing his first term). Commissioners Fabisiak and Slutsky are not eligible for reappointment.

The Colorado Water Quality Control Act requires that members be appointed so as to achieve geographical representation and to reflect the various interests in water in the state. Anyone interested in applying to be a member of the Water Quality Control Commission should submit an application and resume at your earliest convenience, but at least by February 15, 2018, to the Governor's Office of Boards and Commissions.
